use_hub_github_action *Hubverse GitHub Action setup*

Description

Sets up common continuous integration (CI) workflows for a hub that is hosted on GitHub using [GitHub Actions](#). Available actions are hosted in repository [hubverse-org/hubverse-actions](#). The function creates the necessary directories and downloads the requested GitHub Action yaml file.

Usage

```
use_hub_github_action(name, ref = NULL)
```

Arguments

name	Name of workflow, i.e. the name of one of the action repository directories containing a GitHub Action workflow .yaml file.
ref	Desired Git reference, usually the name of a tag ("v0.1.0") or branch ("main"). Other possibilities include a commit SHA ("d1c516d") or "HEAD" (meaning "tip of remote's default branch"). If not specified, defaults to the latest published release of hubverse-org/hubverse-actions (https://github.com/hubverse-org/hubverse-actions/releases)
